## *Frequently Asked Questions*

### **What is The LOFT@OCTC?**

Owensboro Community and Technical College, in conjunction with Daviess County/Owensboro Public Schools, is offering a summer tutoring service for students finishing first grade through high school. The curriculum will focus on reading, writing, and math and is geared toward helping your child catch up, get ahead, or simply not lose valuable skills during the summer break. Taught by leading educators from this area, The LOFT@OCTC will use exciting and interactive learning techniques to ensure that your child enjoys learning at his or her own pace.

### **When will classes be held?**

The LOFT@OCTC will offer two summer sessions that will each last three weeks. Classes will meet twice per week (resulting in six total classes) for sixty minutes per class period. The June session will be held June 15 to July 2, and students can choose from Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday sessions. The July sessions will be held July 6 through July 23, and will also be offered Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday. For each class, there are four time slots per day to choose from.

### **Where will classes be held?**

The classes will be held at the downtown location of Owensboro Community and Technical College, 1501 Frederica Street.

### **Who will teach the classes?**

Local teachers who were highly recommended by students, principals, and parents will teach the classes. These teachers will help students not only learn the material, but also love the subject. The teachers who are part of The LOFT@OCTC are teachers your child will always remember!

### **What is the student to teacher ratio?**

All classes will have a maximum of six students to ensure that your child is getting quality attention from his or her teacher and to help your child learn at his or her own pace.

### **What is the cost of the tutoring program?**

The LOFT@OCTC is a very affordable option for your child. As low as \$15 an hour, each monthly session is only \$90.

### **Can my child still enroll?**

Yes! But space is limited so sign up NOW! Each class section will be capped at six students to ensure that your child is getting quality attention and can learn at his or her own pace.
