What is Scrip?

Scrip is a fundraising program in which OCS purchases gift cards and certificates at a discounted rate then sells them at face value.

What are the benefits of using Scrip?

- The Scrip program is designed to fundraise on everyday purchases. With numerous, wide-ranging local and national retailers participating, you are able to purchase and use gift cards and certificates at places you already frequent.
- No door-to-door sales. No selling products to friends and family.
- Earn money to keep or to apply toward tuition. Once your family reaches it's annual goal, you begin earning rebates on additional SCRIP certificate purchases.
- Using Scrip cards at retail stores and for online purchases limits your exposure to data breaches or credit card fraud.

scrip¹ [*skrip*] **noun** – a certificate to be exchanged for goods, as at a company store.

How do I start?

For new families, it's best to come in to the Scrip Office to begin. Visit the Scrip Office in the OCS Central Office at the rear of the high school building, 1524 W. Parrish Avenue. We can talk you through the ordering process and ensure you have a username in our system.

How do I order Scrip?

You can place an order anytime in the Scrip office and once you have a username, you can submit orders online (shopwithscrip.com) or sign up to pay for orders using PrestoPay (see below).

You can submit orders at the Scrip Office which is open Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. during the school year (10:00-5:00 in the summer). Payment is due at time of order, **check or cash only**.

You can send an order to the Scrip Office via your student on Tuesdays and Fridays. Orders are picked up from each school and returned the same day (pending inventory). Pick up an order form from the Scrip office or find it at owensborocatholic.org on the "SCRIP" tab.

What is PrestoPay?

PrestoPay is online payment which securely debits your checking or savings account for nearly instantaneous access to electronic gift cards.

PrestoPay enables you to purchase ScripNow gift cards at shopwithscrip.com. These electronic gift cards are available to you within minutes to print or use from your mobile device. This is helpful if you're not quite the planner or you have an unforeseen, needed purchase

outside of our business hours and find yourself making a purchase at one of our ScripNow retailers.

Is there an option for mobile devices?

MyScripWallet.com is a mobile site (supported by most devices, including iPhone and Android) that makes using eCards with your device even easier.

What is the annual goal for each family?

This year, every OCS family is asked to fundraise a total of \$175. But you're not going to want to stop there! That is when the rebate program kicks in!

What is the rebate program?

After you've reached your goal, 75% of every dollar in profit goes back to you or towards the following year's tuition - depending on what option you selected at registration. Once you get into the habit of buying Scrip, and with a little planning, your rebate will add up quickly.

It's easy to exceed your goal!

Many of our retailers, especially our local vendors, are very generous with their rebate percentages. You can easily average at least a 5% rebate at places where you were going to spend money anyway*! For example:

	Rebate	Monthly Spending	Annual Earning
Kroger	4%	\$480	\$230
WalMart	2.5%	\$250	\$75
Casual Dining	10% (avg)	\$150	\$180
Fast Food	8% (avg)	\$100	\$96
Department Stores	5% (avg)	\$150	\$90
Home Improvement	4% (avg)	\$130	\$62
Gas/Automotive	3% (avg)	\$240	\$86
TOTAL		\$1,500	\$819

*Many of our families have also used Universal Discover or American Express Scrip cards for monthly expenses such as Kenergy, TimeWarner Cable, DirecTV - anywhere payment by credit card is accepted!

From this example, the \$819 earned by this OCS family will translate into a \$483 reduction in their tuition the following year. ($\$819 - \$175 \text{ goal} \times .75 \text{ rebate} = \483)

If there is a place you frequent that isn't part of our Scrip program, mention the program to the store's manager or let us know of their interest. We are always happy to talk to vendors and increase the scope of our program.
